

PRIVACY POLICY

General Information

The following information will provide you with an easy to navigate overview of what will happen with your personal data when you visit our website. The term “personal data” comprises all data that can be used to personally identify you.

According to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), we are obliged to inform you on how your personal data is administered by us.

Information About the Responsible Party (referred to as the “controller” in the GDPR)

Conference Organizing Body (“us”, “we”, or “our”) operates the <http://spsympo25.ise.pw.edu.pl> website (the “SPSympoWebsite”).

This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information when you use our SPSympoWebsite.

We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

We use your personal data for providing and improving the SPSympoWebsite. By using the SPSympoWebsite, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

Information Collection and Use

While using our SPSympoWebsite, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you.

Log Data

We collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our SPSympoWebsite (“Log Data”). This Log Data may include information such as your computer’s Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our SPSympoWebsite that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a web site and stored on your computer’s hard drive.

We use “cookies” to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our SPSympoWebsite.

Service Providers

We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate our SPSympoWebsite, to provide the SPSympoWebsite on our behalf, to perform services related to SPSympoWebsite.

These third parties have access to your personal data only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.

Security

The security of your personal data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

International Transfer

Your information, including Personal Information, may be transferred to, and maintained on, computers located outside your country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside Poland and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the information, including personal data, to Poland and process it there.
